- Junction of two different cycles between two academic years
  - PHASE III (Academic Year 2007-08)
  - PHASE II (Academic Year 2008-09)

# Assessment Cycle 2007-08

## ➤ PHASE III

- Data collection completed
- Statistical data analysis currently underway (OIPRA)
  - Results to be reported back to academic programs and administrative units (except course-specific data)
    - Point of Service (POS) Surveys (administrative units)
    - University-wide Surveys
      - Graduating Senior Exit Survey
      - Faculty Course Evaluations
      - Organization-specific data collections

# Assessment Cycle (2008-09)

## ➤ PHASE I (Almost Completed)

- Development, Submission & Approval of Annual Assessment Plan (AAP)
  - 43 AAPs currently under review by Institutional Assessment Committee (IAC)
  - IAC comments/recommendations will be shared with program officers for appropriate action
  - IAC will approve revised AAPs
  - Approved AAPs will be officially on record in AMOS

# Next Steps...

## Annual Assessment Report

### ➤ PHASE III (Academic Year 2007-08)

- Annual Assessment Report (AAR) and Action Plan (AP)
  - AAR/AP Guidelines and Instructions distributed to program officers
  - Programs analyze assessment data results and make determinations on the extent to which expected target outcomes were met

# Next Steps...

## Action Plan

- Based on data findings, programs develop strategies to address weaknesses and/or benchmark strengths via the **Action Plan**
- Upon submission and approval of the AAR and AP, OIPRA will certify each program for compliance with the assessment cycle (pursuant to university policy)
- Assessment results will be officially on record in AMOS

- PHASE II (Academic Year 2008-09)
  - AAP implemented
    - Data collection conducted throughout the academic year

- **AMEE:** Athens State University's Assessment Management Entry Evaluator
  - Data collection and analysis component
