What is MSDNAA?

The Microsoft Developer Network Academic Alliance (MSDNAA) program offers an inexpensive way for students and faculty to obtain select Microsoft software products for use in their classes. The College of Business at Athens State University joined MSDNAA in Fall 2007. Each semester students in Business courses that teach/use select Microsoft products will be authorized, at the request of their professor, to download/purchase those products via the MSDNAA program.

What is ELMS?

Provided by e-academy—a Microsoft partner—ELMS (e-academy License Management System) provides a customized website for Athens State University through which authorized Business faculty/students can download/purchase Microsoft software. Software may be available for free download, purchase on CD at a low price, or through both download/CD.

Software Titles Available

The following software is currently available:

- Microsoft Access 2003 download only
- Microsoft Access 2007 download only
- Microsoft Expression Web download only
- Microsoft Project Professional 2003 download only
- Microsoft Project Professional 2007 download or CD
- Microsoft Visio Professional 2003 download only
- Microsoft Visio Professional 2007 download or CD

Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint are not available through the MSDNAA program, but students should check http://www.ultimatesteal.com to see if they are eligible for a special discount from Microsoft.
