WHAT IS AVID?

AVID is a system that targets potential college students who need support. AVID prepares them by teaching them college readiness skills. Students are given academic support through tutors.

Athens City Schools conducts a criminal background check on prospective employees.

JOB DESCRIPTION: Tutors will be trained to tutor with the Socratic method. They will work with small groups of intermediate, middle, or high school students under the supervision of a teacher in an AVID classroom during the school day. Tutors serve as guides and facilitators of students' learning through questioning, writing, thinking, and discussing. Tutors' schedules are worked around their college schedules and can be from 1 to 6 hours per week. Tutoring is held on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

QUALIFICATIONS: Successful college students bring a sufficient level of expertise to the tutoring positions. This expertise, along with tutor training, equips the college students to begin working in AVID classrooms. Students with strong math or science skills are especially welcome. The best qualification is that you care about making a difference in the lives of students. Who knows? It may change your life, too!
