

2013-14 Athens State University Foundation Distinguished Scholarly/Creative Work Award

Criteria for Distinguished Scholarly/Creative Work

Candidates for the Distinguished Scholarly/Creative Work award must be full-time faculty members whose university careers are distinguished by truly outstanding scholarly or creative activity. Nominees for the award should have achieved the highest recognition from peers and/or officials of peer-reviewed publications including:

- ° Scholarly or creative work must be credible, significant to the university or college, and be ongoing and current;
- ° Scholarly or creative work must enhance faculty expertise in their discipline;
- ° Scholarly or creative work must make a contribution to the faculty member's discipline;
- ° Scholarly or creative work is published or placed;
- Scholarly or creative work results in lectures, presentations, etc.;
- Scholarly methodology and analysis are valid. In the case of creative work, there is evidence of originality of work;
- ° Scholarly or creative work is clear and complete;
- Scholarly or creative work must contribute to the University, regional, national or international intellectual communities while increasing the visibility of the University.

Nomination Process

- ° Individuals making nominations should complete the nomination form at the end of this document.
- Attach a Letter of Nomination that addresses the nominee's qualification for the award.
- ° Submit the form and letter to the department chair or dean of the nominee by March 3, 2014.
- ^o The nominee will be notified and asked to submit the Nomination Dossier to the Associate VP of Academic Affairs no later than <u>March 31, 2014</u>. (Dossier requirements are listed below).
- Obssiers will be reviewed by the Faculty Awards Selection Committee and the winner announced at the 2014 Athens State University Honors Convocation.

Nomination Dossier Requirements:

- ° The Athens State University Foundation Faculty Award Distinguished Scholarly/Creative Work Award nomination form.
- ° Letter of nomination (two-page maximum).
- ° Nominee's two-page statement (two-page maximum) describing scholarly/creative work.
- ° Copies of recent scholarly work or photos of creative work products.
- ° Up-to-date curriculum vitae with emphasis on scholarly activities and/or creative productions.
- ° Letter of support from the department chair or dean (one page maximum).
- ° Two recommendations from peers (one-page maximum each). At least one of the recommendations must come from a peer within the same discipline at another university.
