Eligibility

Ceremony

- Caps, gowns and tassels can be purchased from the University Bookstore anytime between now and August 5, 2017. The total cost is \$40 plus tax.
- Tickets are not required for the ceremony, and there is no limit to the number of guests invited.
- Report to Griffin Theatre, McCandless Hall, at 8:00 a.m. for line-up and instructions.

Honors

Students who have earned at least 45 hours of Athens State University credit at the end of the graduation semester are eligible for Honors.

- Honors designations recognized at the ceremony and listed in the program will be determined by the Athens State GPA as of the end of the previous semester based on the following:
 - > 3.50-3.69 *Cum Laude* (bronze medallion)
 - > 3.70-3.89 *Magna Cum Laude* (silver medallion)
 - > 3.90 4.0 Summa Cum Laude (gold medallion)
- Honors printed on your transcript and posted on your diploma will be determined by the final Athens State GPA.

 Honors medallions will be available in the University Bookstore for purchase beginning July 25, 2017. The cost is \$15.

DIPLOMAS WILL NOT BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE GRADUATION CEREMONY. THEY WILL BE MAILED BY AUGUST 21, 2017.

**Transcripts should be used to provide employers with proof of graduation.
Graduation information should be posted on the transcripts by the Records Office a day or two after grades are due (August 3). If you need a transcript, please contact the Records office at 256-233-8131.

Village Photographers is pleased to be the official graduation photographer for your school.


Village Photographers will take professional pictures of <u>each and every</u> graduate as they receive their diplomas and exit the stage at the graduation ceremony.
