

Eligibility

If you have questions regarding your eligibility to graduate, **REVIEW YOUR DEGREE WORKS PLAN OF STUDY AND CONSULT WITH YOUR ADVISOR.**

Ceremony

- Report to the Sandridge Student Center Ballroom, at 8:00 a.m. for line-up and instructions.
- Tickets are not required for the ceremony, and there is no limit to the number of guests invited.
- Graduation supplies are available at the University Bookstore, and can be purchased anytime between now and May 2, 2020. The prices (**not including tax**) are listed below:
 - cap/gown \$50 (cap by itself is \$8.50)
 - tassel \$8.50
 - Masters hood \$50

Dress:

- Men – wear a collared shirt, slacks and comfortable shoes
- Women – wear slacks, dresses/skirts and comfortable shoes

Honors

To be eligible for a degree with honor, a student must have completed at least 45 undergraduate semester hours at the University.

- Degrees with honor are based on performance in all undergraduate academic work completed at Athens State University, with the exception of any coursework excluded by course forgiveness or academic bankruptcy.
- The following honors may be awarded to undergraduate students:
 - Institutional GPA of 3.9 - 4.0 *Summa Cum Laude* (gold medallion)
 - Institutional GPA of 3.70 - 3.89 *Magna Cum Laude* (silver medallion)
 - Institutional GPA of 3.50 -3.69 *Cum Laude* (bronze medallion)
- Since all grades for the final semester may not be available in time for commencement ceremonies and printing of commencement programs, degree with honor designations for a commencement ceremony are unofficial.
- Final academic honor designations are determined after grades for the final semester have been posted. Final, official honor designations will be reflected on the Athens State transcript and on the Athens State diploma.
- Honor medallions will be available in the University Bookstore for purchase after April 15, 2020. The cost is \$20 plus tax.

Diplomas and Transcripts

- Diplomas will be mailed to **all** graduates by May 18, 2020. None will be given at the ceremony.
- Transcripts
 - should be used to provide employers with proof of graduation.
 - graduation information should be posted on the transcripts by the Records Office a day or two after grades are due (April 29, 2020).
