Dr. Baird received her Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from Auburn University, then earned her Masters in Elementary Education and doctorate in Elementary Curriculum from the University of Alabama with minors in Early Childhood, Educational Psychology, and statistics. Dr. Baird's post-doctoral education continued at Spring Hill College with Theology, and minors in Morality, Ethics, and Religious Education.

Dr. Baird has taught at such institutions as the University of Alabama, Austin College, University of West Alabama, Stillman College, and Athens State University. Her teaching career in a K12 setting was at Meek High School and Meek Elementary. She also taught at Richards Junior High. However, Dr. Baird didn't let the walls of the learning institution define her career, but gave of herself to those most in need when she worked setting up schools in United Nations refugee camps of the Yucatan Peninsula during the flight of villages from genocide within warring factions.

She has done research in her career on schooling of the peoples of Central America and the suicides and spiritual development of the youth of America. As her career has progressed, there is a shift of focus from solely education to education and spiritual development. Dr. Baird has worked in her career to further the growth of children all over the world with greater knowledge and emotional growth. She has left a strong, positive imprint on the world, and we appreciate her work and dedication in all facets of life. She has shaped the teachers in the classroom to be better teachers, and now she continues her journey in helping enlighten the spiritual leaders and thinkers to delve deeper.
