
- 4.8 million Alabama's population











Who We Have is Who We've Got



Jobs and Workers by Skill Level, Alabama, 2012





A Middle-Skill Gap


Middle-skill jobs account for 60 percent of Alabama's labor market, but only 47 percent of the state's workers are trained to the middle-skill level.


