



## Degree Works: Official Plan of Study

Degree Works is a tool that enables a student, their success coach and faculty advisor to review past, present and future academic coursework to evaluate which degree requirements are complete and which degree requirements are still needed.

### Key Reasons to View Your Often

- Degree Works allows you to see how your transferrable credit hours/coursework has been allocated to degree requirements after your official transcript(s) from all previous institutions attended is/are **received** and **evaluated** by the university.

- Degree Works allows you to view and familiarize yourself with required core coursework and hours for your chosen bachelor's major, minor if applicable, and overall graduation requirements.

### Planning Course Schedule

- a) Degree Works provides detailed course information for all courses that meet specific degree requirements. When you click on a hyperlinked **"Still needed"** course in your plan, a pop-up gives brief information about the course and its availability in an upcoming semester.
- b) The day after your course registration, Degree Works "plugs" the course into your plan.

- c) It is important to review your Degree Works plan not only before course registration but also the day after course registration or after a schedule modification. This practice helps to ensure your course selection meets the appropriate degree requirements.

### How-to Access

- 2) Select: "myAthens Portal," log in using your credentials (contact the [Help Desk](#)<sup>2</sup> for access support)
- 3) Under "Tools" select: "Degree Works" link
