2. A. I am willing to spend extra time studying, if needed, due to the format of an Internet course.
B. I think this class will require less time than a regular class.
3. A. I understand that I am still responsible to meet the course requirements, due dates, and that some tests and/or labs may be given on campus.
B. I think Internet courses allow you to work at your own pace.
4. A. I am very familiar with communication via email.
B. I rarely use email.
5. A. I enjoy reading and feel that I comprehend materials easily.
B. I learn best with repetition and need to hear an instructor lecture.
6. A. I am confident in word processing (highlighting, formatting, and copying/pasting text).
B. I can type fairly well, but do not have other computer skills.

B. I would not feel comfortable calling an instructor.
