

CLEP and DSST Credit Equivalency Grid Athens State University Revised September 30, 2021

Minimum exam scores are required for award of credit. The level of credit awarded and course equivalencies are determined using the <u>American Council on Education (ACE)</u> recommendations as of the revision date of this document, and are subject to change without notice. Tests taken prior to the revision date may be eligible for a different award based on a case-by-case review of published ACE recommendations at the time the test was taken.

Credit will be awarded if it does not duplicate other earned academic credit. Credit awarded for each test will fulfill requirements in the areas as indicated in the first column; **otherwise credit will count towards general elective hours only.** Note- LL refers to lower level credit and UL refers to upper level credit noted in red.
