T&C Stamping was founded by John Turner and Mike Coleman, a family owned business. They are an S corporation in Athens with 80 employees, and they make \$25 million in sales annually selling parts for small appliances, outdoor power equipment, and the automotive industry. They value safety, quality, and sound financial management. Mr. Mike Coleman, one of the owners, stressed the importance of seeing things from an owner's perspective and being customer-driven. 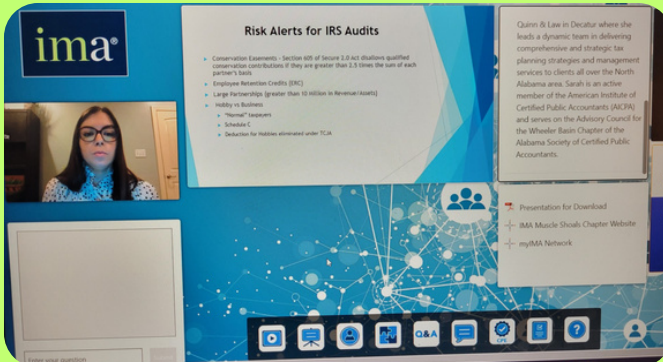
