The objective of the major in Applied Management (APM) is to provide students with a comprehensive business education which will prepare them to enter managerial employment, advance within the management field, or assist in the development of individuals who hold those positions. The degree in Applied Management encompasses the conventional business curriculum and provides students with a strong foundation in the traditional management curriculum. In addition to the Applied Management Professional Courses core curriculum, students must complete a Concentration in Leadership, Manufacturing, or Small Business Management or they may choose a Tailored Business Concentration.
