ABC (Alternative Baccalaureate-Level Certificate) Enrollment Guide now called *Provisional Certificate in a Teaching Field*

According to the Alabama State Department of Education, the Alternative Baccalaureate-Level Certificate Approach is for **K-12 and 6-12 teaching fields**. Certification based on this alternative approach may **ONLY** be requested by an <u>employing</u> Alabama county/city superintendent or eligible non-public school administrator. An individual should contact the school system or eligible non-public school in which employment is desired for information concerning certificate eligibility.

Applicants must hold a bachelor's or higher degree with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 (increasing to 2.75 effective July 2016) on a 4.0 scale.

Certification based on this approach consists of **3 levels** (A, B, C).
