- You can purchase your cap, gown and tassel from the University Bookstore anytime between now and August 17.

- 3.50-3.69 *Cum Laude* (bronze medallion)
- 3.70-3.89 *Magna Cum Laude* (silver medallion)
- 3.90 4.0 Summa Cum Laude (gold medallion)
