If a student, at any time, changes from the Math major with minor in Education to the Math major without the Education minor, the student must meet all requirements for that major; therefore mathematics electives should be chosen carefully. Students cannot earn a double major in math by completing requirements of both programs. Students desiring a strong preparation for graduate school should take MA 321, MA 401, and MA 452.
